


The City is updating the Community Plan in order to help shape the future of Clairemont for the next 20 years.

- Provides framework for improved bike/walk/transit network





#### Forecasted Population and Job Growth









# PROTECT OUR QUALITY OF LIFE

# WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS FOR RECREATION AND OPEN SPACE?


- Targets areas for preservation of open space



### **Subcommittee Composition**

- •7 members total
- •4 members from planning group
  - Appointed by planning group board members
- •3 members from community
  - Application required
  - Selected by Subcommittee

# **Goals for Community Outreach**

- Engage a diverse array of community stakeholders and members (business owners/home owners/renters/etc.)
- Conduct an open and transparent process that incorporates multiple channels for participation
- Provides a forum for all opinions to be heard and discussed throughout the process
